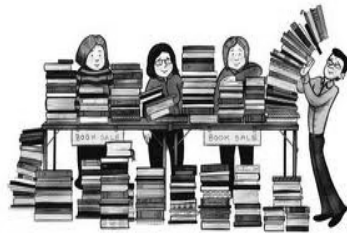


FRIENDS of LIBRARY ANNUAL MEETING in JULY

The Library is excited to announce the addition of ebooks for your readers and nooks. Watch for ebooks in August or September.

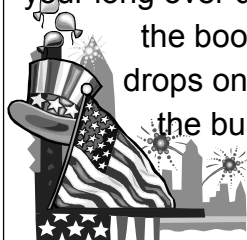
